

# How to Make Your Own Mini Gallery

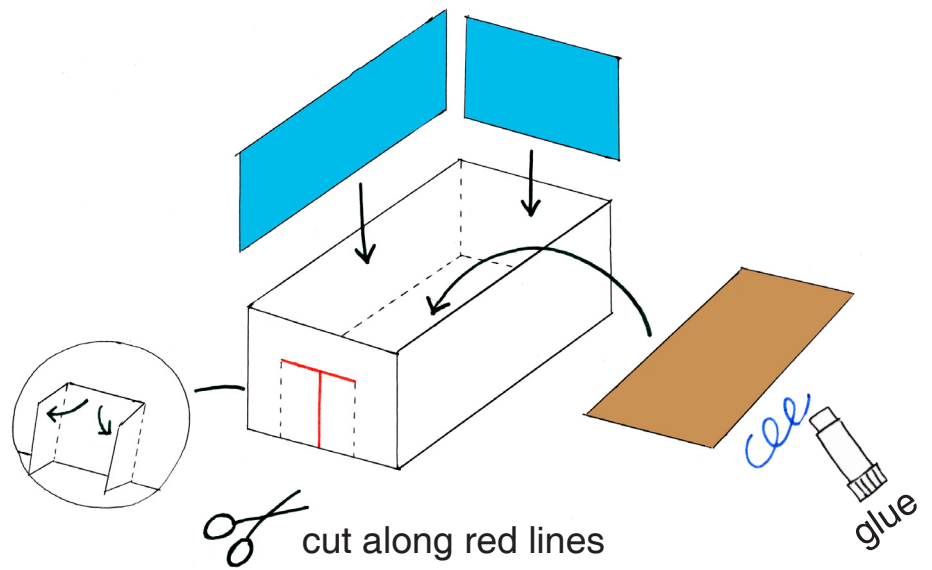
materials needed:

- \* 1 shoe box
- \* construction paper
- \* glue stick
- \* scissors
- \* 1 sheet of tracing paper
- \* printouts of mini artworks

## step 1

Start by taking an old shoe box and cutting a doorway. Cut along red lines and fold on dotted lines.

Next, cut out walls and doors using your favorite color of construction paper. Glue the floor down.

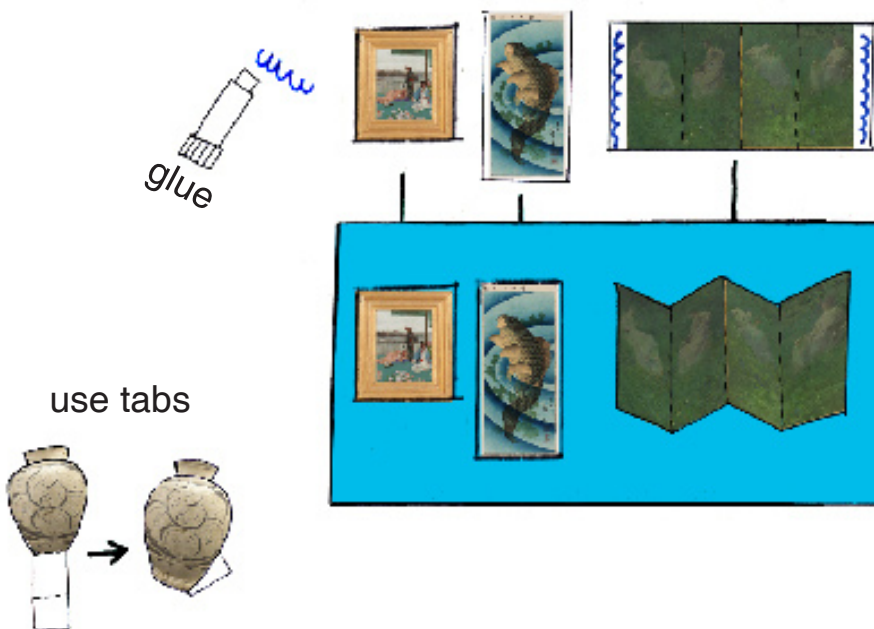


## step 2

Pick your favorite artworks from the printouts on pages three and four of this guide.

Glue your paintings and screens to the paper that will cover the walls of your gallery.

Use the tabs to prop up vases and screens.

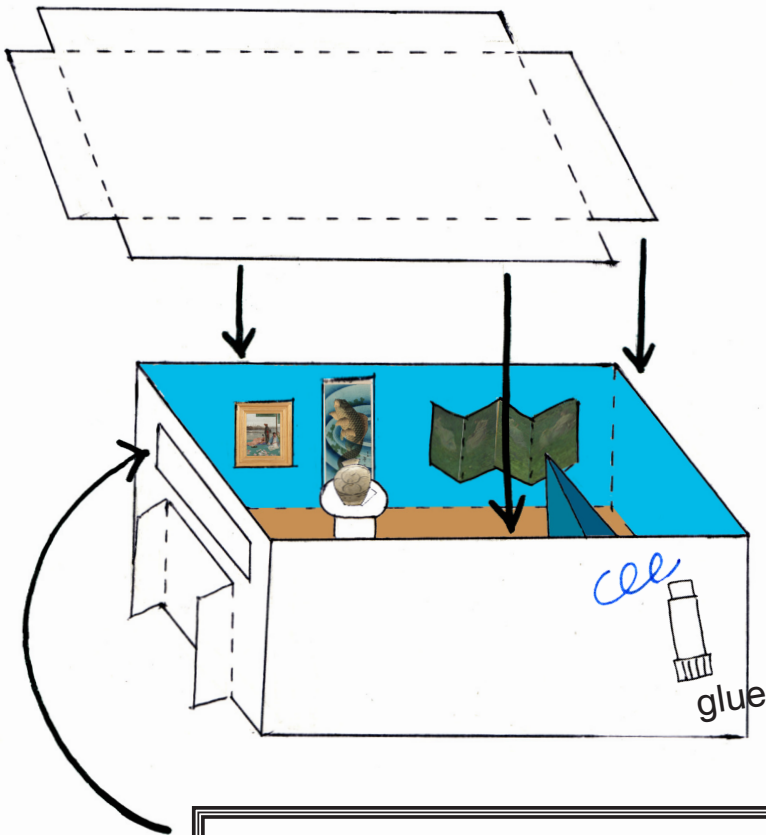
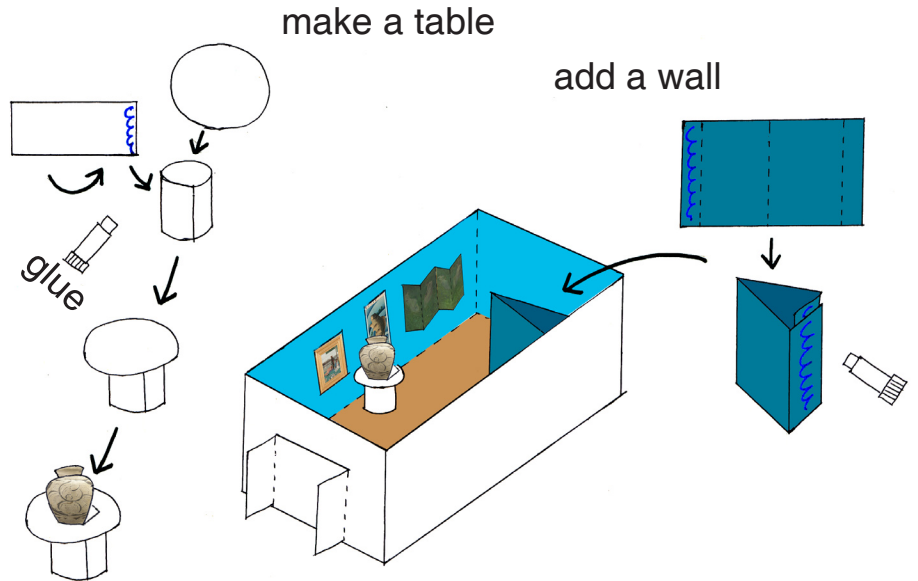


# step 3

Now glue your walls into the gallery.

You can add extra walls and a table for your objects.

Fold construction paper into either a tube shape or a triangle and glue it in.

# step 4

For the final step, cut a piece of tracing paper large enough to cover your gallery. Cut squares away from the corners and glue the tabs to the top outside walls of your gallery.

Add a title to your gallery to complete your project!
